
Dear Senator Aylwin:

I am writing to report on the efforts I have made concerning the subject we talked about in January. I believe that by now you will have received an application for the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars. The competition is already closed for the current year and I believe that Radomiro Tomic has applied to work at the Center from September until February. However, there is another competition next October for which you would be eligible.

I have also talked to the head of the Institute of Advanced Studies at Princeton. I think, in his case as well as the Woodrow Wilson Center, the fact that you are not fluent in English is a serious drawback. Another problem is that most of your writing is on legal rather than political problems and those legal problems are mainly in the area of public administration. I will, however, keep looking for possibilities in that area. You may want to write to ^{Professor} Michael Francis at the University of Notre Dame (Notre Dame, Indiana) to see if there are any possibilities at that university.

In the meantime, I hope that we will keep in touch and that you will come to see Princeton if you pass through New York on any of your trips.
